Dear Parent/Guardian:

Each year at this time of the summer our thoughts begin to turn from vacations toward the beginning of another school year. I hope that the past weeks have been relaxing and restful and that you are as enthusiastic about the upcoming year as I am. To assist you and your student in preparing for the first days of school, please find below some important information for you to review together. Please take some time to review and navigate this resource.

* We have posted the student handbook on the Roxbury.org website. You may access this information by opening the roxbury.org website, click on "high school," then scroll over the student life tab on the navy banner and click on the student handbook.

* Dress Code - Our updated dress code is intended to support the teaching and learning process. I ask your assistance in this matter by ensuring that your student dress according to the school policy. I have included a copy of the dress code with this correspondence.

*** Roxbury High School Cell Phone Policy for the 2024-2025 School Year**

To ensure an optimal learning environment for all students, Roxbury High School has revised its cell phone usage protocols for the 2024-2025 academic school year. All students will be required to place cell phones into designated cell phone caddies when entering all classrooms. At no time may a student possess a cell phone during class time. Students found in violation of this policy will face disciplinary actions as outlined in the student code of conduct. However, students are permitted to use their cell phones during lunch periods in the cafeteria.

* I would like to call your attention to our attendance regulations regarding the number of permissible unexcused absences allowed in a specific course: Eight absences in a full-year course, six absences in a three-quarter course, four absences in a half-year course, and two absences in a quarter course. In addition, medical notes will only be accepted within ten days of the student's absence.

* Once again, we will maintain our agreement with the Roxbury Police Department, and we will be receiving assistance with school security. Officer Nicole Parichuk will serve as the liaison between the Police Department and the school district.

* Back-to-School Night will occur during the first month of school. Please mark your calendar and join us on Thursday, September 5, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.

On behalf of the administrative team, teachers, counselors, coaches, and advisors, I extend to you an invitation to work with us in educating your student. We hope to instill in each of them the desire to be lifelong learners and to help each one to grow into a valuable community member and productive citizen. Please contact your student's counselor or teacher regarding any concerns. As partners in the educational process, good communication will be necessary for our efforts to be effective. Together we will make it a great year to be a Gael!

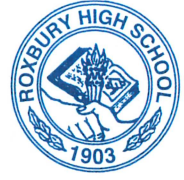

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Dear Grade 12 Parents and Students:

This year, we are continuing our process for digital submission of forms and documents that must be read and approved by parents and students. All of the required documents will be posted on the Genesis portal. Therefore, parents (and in some cases students) will read and submit the responses electronically.

Required documents found in Genesis include: Emergency Contact Form, Code of Conduct Form, Fan Code of Conduct Form, Media Consent Form, and the Technology Acknowledgement Form. For grade 12 students, the Public Law 107-110 form should also be completed, and the Family Life Curriculum exclusion letter. These forms will be available on August 13. The Free and Reduced Lunch Form can be found in the parent portal as well.

Information regarding school (student) accident insurance information is posted on the RHS website under the Parent/General Resources tab. I would encourage parents to consider this low-cost option because the District does not carry student accident insurance. Underclassmen pictures will be taken on August 29 and August 30. For underclass package ordering, please go to the link on our website and use the school login code 25-23R.

Once all forms have been submitted, reviewed, and approved, parents will be given access via Genesis to student schedules. Student schedules will be available on the parent portal after 3 pm on August 14 for those who have completed all required digital "paperwork."

Senior class portraits are scheduled for August 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23 and retakes will be taken on November 4, 2024. Students or parents are responsible for scheduling any retake appointments. Also, for your information, we will hold a Financial Aid Parent Program on October 24.

The first day of school for all students is Wednesday, August 28th. Back to School Night will be held on Thursday, September 5, at 7:00 pm. Please mark your calendars. We hope that you find all the information on our website regarding the opening of school convenient for you and that you appreciate our efforts to reduce the cost of paper and postage. 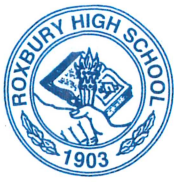

- * **School begins at 7:25 a.m.** You should report to the homeroom on your schedule which will be available on Genesis after 3 pm on August 14.
- * Your bus top and pick-up times are listed in the Genesis portal
- * In your homeroom you will receive pertinent information regarding the school year which will be shared with you.
- * Classroom instruction begins after homeroom in all courses. A full day of school will conclude at 2:07 p.m. and buses depart at 2:14 p.m.

As you know, senior parking applications have been processed. Be sure to park in the parking space assigned to you. Parking rules and regulations are in effect as of August 28, 2024. Please remember that the speed limit on campus is 15 mph. Be a safe driver!

Open lunch will start on Monday, September 23. Seniors can check in the Main Office to determine if their application was approved. Remember there is a 25-hour service component for each semester to qualify.
