#### Winter 2024

- Prepare and register for standardized tests (SAT and/or ACT)
- Research and begin visiting colleges

#### Spring 2024

- Continue visiting colleges
- Attend college fairs
- Start building your list
- Standardized tests
- Letters of recommendation

#### **Summer 2024**

- Continue Spring Timeline
- Start your college essays
- Register for Common Application Opens August 1st

#### Fall 2024

- Meet with your counselor
- Begin to apply to colleges
- Standardized tests
- College essays
- Letters of recommendation
- Scholarships and financial aid (FAFSA)

- Next test date February 10, 2024

- Your list should contain schools that are:
  - Safety (Admission & Financial) Ο
  - Target Ο
  - Reach Ο
- Your list should be YOUR list, which fits YOUR needs
- Look at school's data:
  - GPA, Test Scores, Difficulty of Program, Graduation Rate, Acceptance Rate Ο
    - Even if metrics match those of average accepted student, if the admit rate is low, it is a reach!

## NCAA

- If you participate in athletics at a NCAA Division I or Division II school you will need to register and be declared eligible by the NCAA Clearinghouse.
- Registration must be completed online at <u>www.eligibilitycenter.org</u>
- You should complete the eligibility form in spring of your junior year.
- You will also need to submit SAT and/or ACT scores to the Eligibility Center directly from the testing website.
