

Getting here, getting fed, getting home...

- Morning Arrivals:
 - Buses drop off and pick up students up front
 - \circ Car line is drop and go by G hall (gym) entrance. *Begins at 7:38AM*
- Dismissals (2:30 PM):
 - All students leave through the front door for buses/walking/bikes
 - Car line pickup students wait in AUD <u>Car line begins after buses depart</u>
- **Bus Notes to main office for administrative approval.** Should be handwritten, signed by parent/guardian. This includes BOTH *different bus requests* AND *same bus, different drop spot requests*.
- Grade-level lunches with three different eating areas.
 - **Buying lunch?** Avoid sending cash. Please use My School Bucks to fund your child's account!



Other matters

- No cell phones during the school day! 7:58-2:30.
 - Headphones must have WIRES!
 - Need to contact your child? Please call the main office, we'll get them or get a message to them on your behalf!
- What is Eagle Hour??? Periods 4a & 4b: Grade-level lunch and Triple-E
 - Triple-E: <u>Ensembles (BOC)</u>, <u>Enrichment (Interest Areas)</u>, and <u>Extension (Extra Help)</u>
 - Academic support labs during Lunch periods for BOC participants (MP2-4)

- Lockers (assigned by homeroom), Locks (Must use school issued locks, \$5 fee, cash to HR teacher)
